We have had a very calm start to the half-term. The children are very settled and have returned to the routine of school very quickly after the two-week holiday.

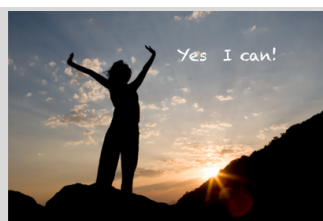
