#### **School Meals - A reminder...**

Due to the limited uptake, and the increase in food costs, we are unfortunately going to have to stop our sandwich meal option after Easter. We will still continue with our main meal and jacket potato options, with a vegetarian option too.

We will be starting a break time snack of PIZZA MUFFINS on a Friday. These will be a muffin base, with a cheese and tomato topping.

The cost of these will be 40p and they can be ordered on the morning. These can be paid for through your child's Parent Pay account.



Unfortunately, Notts County Council who provide our school meals service are having to increase the cost of school meals to £2.55 from 17.4.23.

Hopefully you still find that our school meals offer value for money and enable children to have a healthy cooked meal at school.
